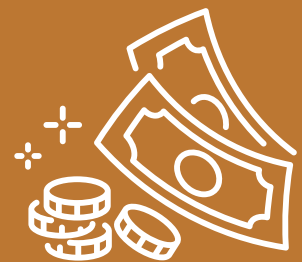

The Native American Environmental Protection Coalition (NAEPC) serves as a testament to the power of unity among federally recognized Tribes. Founded by La Jolla, Pauma, Pechanga, and San Pasqual tribes, this tribal nonprofit 501(c)3 organization now include 31 member tribes across four states. NAEPC's mission centers on fostering collaboration and mutual support among tribes to protect and preserve reservation and aboriginal lands. By building capacity and capabilities, the organization addresses environmental concerns while honoring cultural heritage and sovereignty. Through collective action, NAEPC empowers tribes to ensure sustainable development and environmental stewardship, safeguarding their lands for future generations. This coalition not only exemplifies the strength derived from shared goals but also highlights the importance of tribal guidance and direction in achieving lasting impacts for Indigenous communities. Each Tribe provides a representative to serve on the Board of Directors.
